- 10 points for addressing comments from instructor, grader, and peers on prior drafts
- 15 points for meeting style/length requirements:
 - double-spaced, 12-point font, 1-inch margins
 - pages must be numbered
 - figures from other sources must be credited
 - at least ${\bf 8}$ ${\bf pages},$ excluding figures and bibliography
- 10 points for organization and clarity
- 10 points for effective flow/transitions (between sentences and between paragraphs)
- 5 points for correct spelling and grammar.
